4 A 10 minute shower uses 90 litres 



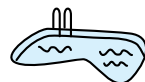

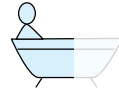

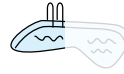

6 A dripping tap uses 12,000 litres a year

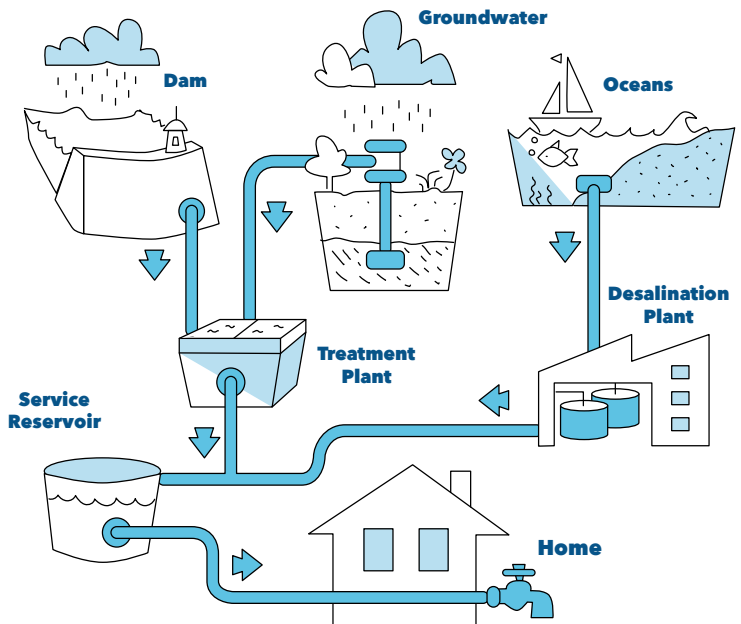


7 A leaking toilet uses 96,000 litres a year
