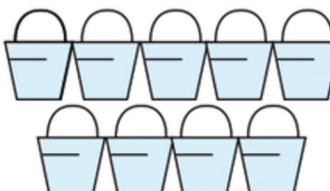
Water Facts

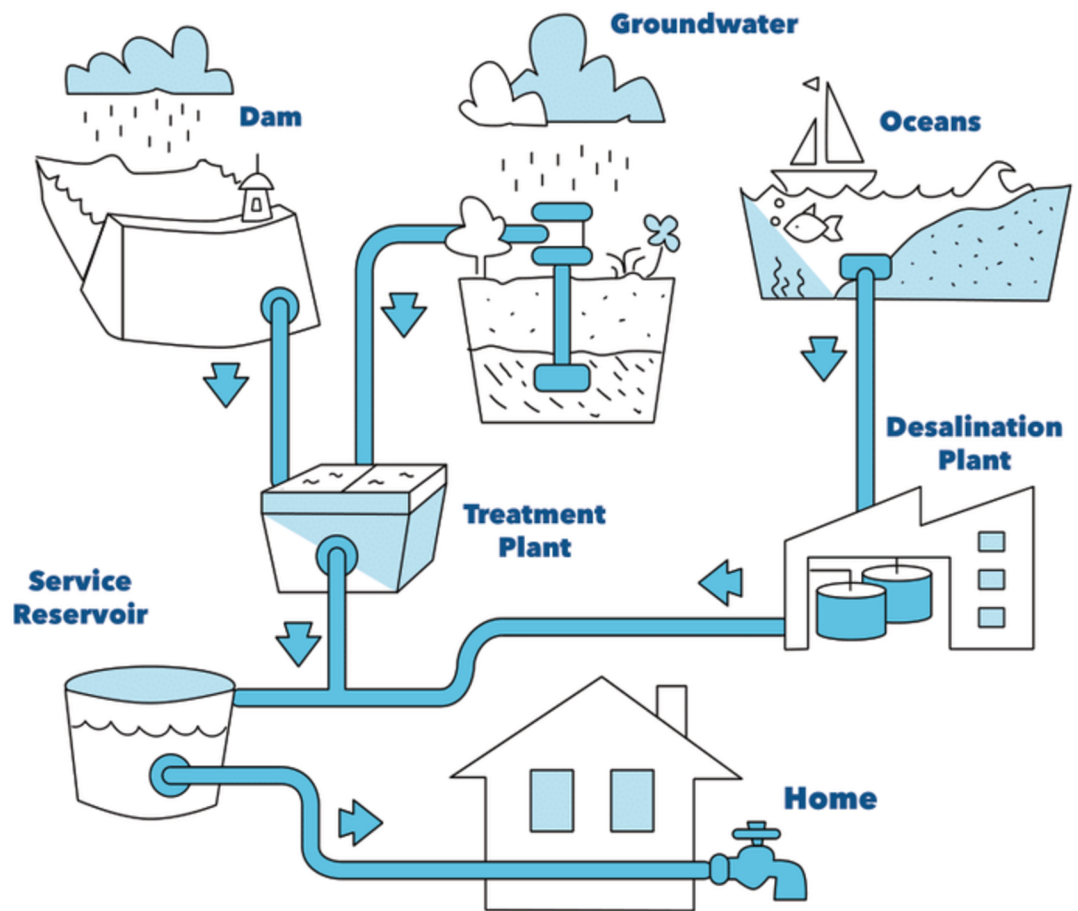
